Resolution No. 09-06

The Board of County Commissioners of Highland County, Ohio, met in Regular Session on January 14, 2009, with the following members present:

Gary Heaton, Thomas Horst, and Shane Wilkin.

Mr. Horst moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the laws of Ohio provide that there shall be fifty (50) Regular Sessions of the Board of County Commissioners of each year, and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to establish Wednesday of each week as Regular Session Day, with the following Thursday set as Regular Session Day when any Wednesday is a legal holiday, and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to establish the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month, as a meeting day, from 8:30 till 12:00 noon, beginning in February, 2009, and

WHEREAS, under ordinary circumstances a quorum of this Board is present at its office at the county seat on Wednesday of each week to conduct such business as may come before it, now




